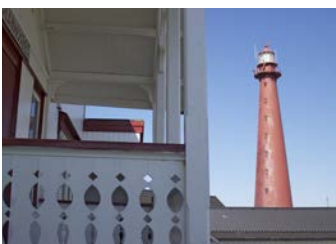

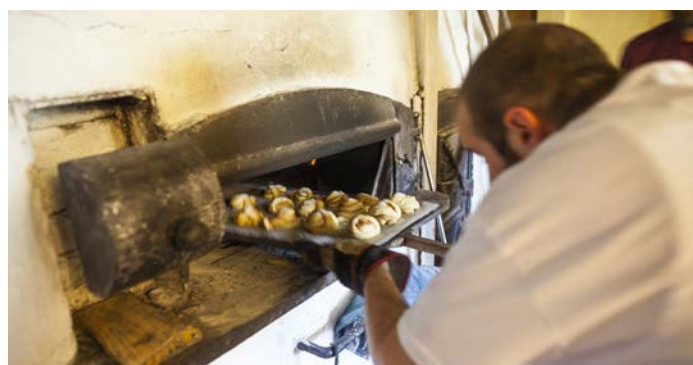

Norwegian Fishing Village Museum, Å in Lofoten

Everyday life in the Fishing Village

AT THE END OF E10, THE KING'S ROAD, you will find one of the best preserved fishing villages in northern Norway. In this authentic environment you will be guided through the adventures of the Lofoten fisheries, and hear stories about vagabonds and everyday heroes from around 1840–1960.

In our summer bakery (using a stone oven from 1844) you can taste several types of traditional bread, and of course our famous cinnamon buns. The old grocery store is full of locally produced food, textiles, local literature, fishing equipment, and a basic selection of groceries. For our youngest guests we have a special activity room. Our souvenir shop near the carpark sells a variety of souvenirs, clothes and books.

The Telecom Museum, Sørvågen

Local and national Telecom history



IN LOFOTEN THE TELEGRAPH was built as early as 1861, with Sørvågen as its end station. In 1906 Sørvågen Telegraph Station sent out the very first wireless morse signals in northern Europe. Find out why and where these signals were sent to, and experience an interesting collection of telecom equipment from our recent and not-so-recent past.

The Telecom Museum in Sørvågen is located in an old telegraph station – a large, white wooden house near the road. Its main theme is the technical, social and cultural development that occurred as a result of the establishment of telegraphy in the Lofoten Islands. See the exhibition of mobile phones, and compare your own phone with the 1973 model.

Meet the Vikings

AT BORG IN LOFOTEN stood the largest viking Longhouse know in the world. More than 1000 years ago, one of northern Norways most powerful Viking Chieftains ruled this area alongside his wife. The Chieftains Longhouse is reconstructed in full scale. Step inside and feel the smell of tar and smoke, study beautiful carvings, handicrafts and architecture. Large outdoor areas surround the museum buildings.

The Viking Chieftains Longhouse, archaeological exhibitions and movie are open all year. Viking Feast – a meal served the Viking way – is available every evening for individuals. Viking Feast and other meals for groups are served every day by request.

Extra activities 15 June–31 August: Sail and row the Viking Ship, participate in Viking activities. Groups can book activities, meals and guided tours all year.

Get to know an important part of Lofotens cultural history. Join us, and travel more than 1000 years back in time.

SKAFTNES FARM IS BEAUTIFULLY situated between the ocean and the green mountains. The farm consists of a farmhouse, a barn, a pier and a boathouse. These are open for visitors, and a guide is available. Here you can learn how the traditional fishermen-farmers lived, and how they fed their families on what the ocean and the small patches of land could provide.

FYGLE MUSEUM – SCHOOL, WORKSHOP AND OFFICE

At Vestvågøy Museum Fygle you can visit a school building from 1898 and a fisherman's cabin from 1834. In the old school you can see a fully furnished classroom, as well as exhibitions with topics like «cobblers workshop», «textile crafts», «teachers home» and «the dentists office».

Objects and artefacts handed down from fishermen-farmers are given extra attention in the exhibitions. Fygle Museum displays a rich collection of objects from the regions past.

The fisherman and the village owner

EXPERIENCE THE HISTORY OF the Lofoten fisherman at one of the best preserved historical properties in Lofoten. The impressive mansion, built in 1815, is surrounded by authentic fisherman cabins and boathouses with traditional wooden boats.

The museum also offers picture slideshows and exhibitions on fishing in Lofoten, harbours and light houses along the coast, traditional handicrafts, interior design, and a beautiful garden with historical plants. In the original "krambua" (kiosk) you can buy local merchandise and gifts. The Lofoten Museum is located by the sea, in beautiful surroundings.

Lofoten Museum/Kystverkmusea is a part of SKREI Experience Center, and is located a short walk from Lofoten Aquarium and Galleri Espolin.

AT THE LOFOTEN AQUARIUM, you can learn about the Arctic Cod – what we call "skrei". The arctic cod migrates from the Barents sea to the waters of Lofoten every winter to spawn. Fisheries in Lofoten are based on fishing this important resource.

In summer and autumn you can see fish farming up close.

The aquarium offers photo exhibitions, film and café with a view. Souvenirs for sale in the gift shop. In addition, you will find an otter pond and a seal pond. It is an absolute highlight to see the feeding of these gracious and fun sea mammals.

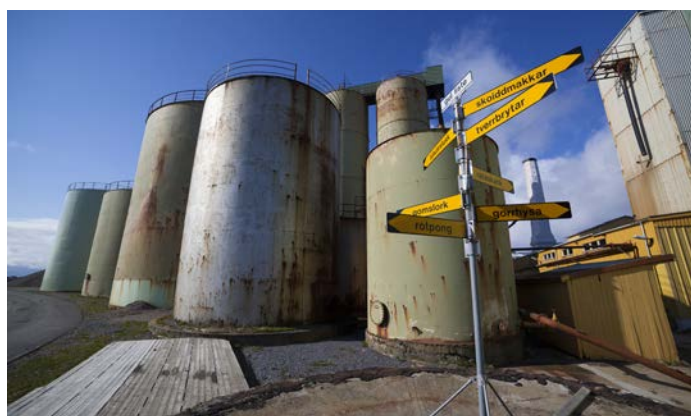
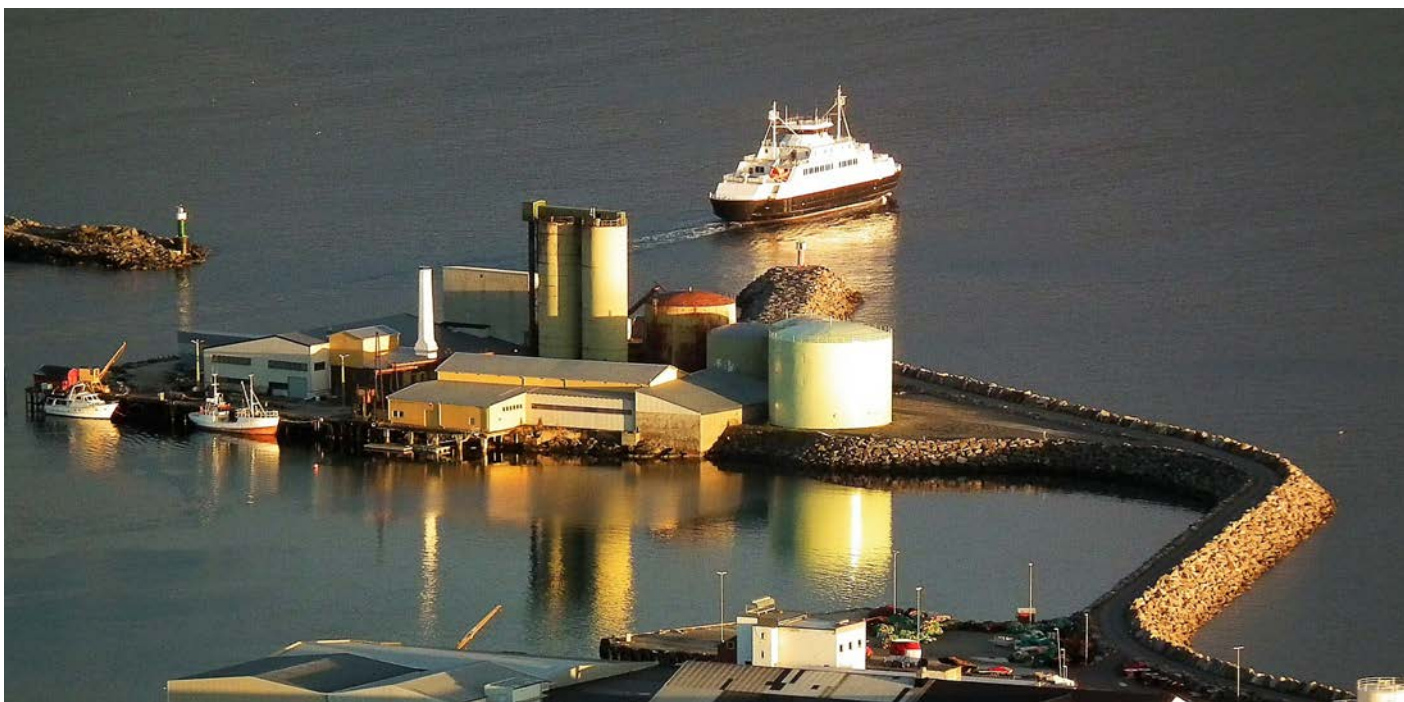

Norwegian Fishing Industry Museum, Melbu

An authentic industrial adventure

THIS NATIONAL MUSEUM of the Norwegian fishing industry explores history, tradition, meaning and possibilities. The museum is located in a former herring oil factory on the outer breakwater at Melbu. See unique photos that portray the history of this important factory, and view a new exhibition about fisheries and the history of the factory in the newly renovated "Melloftet."

One of the tanks formerly used in the fish oil production has been dubbed "Royal Neptune Hall", and regularly houses concerts and other exciting public events due to its exceptional acoustics. Listening to music inside the huge tank is a fantastic audio experience. With a reverberation time of 23 seconds the tank is bound to impress anyone who steps inside.

Melbo – the farm that became a city overnight



IN MELBO MANSION YOU CAN hear the story of the great industrial adventure that took place at the turn of the last century. Over the course of three decades this quiet farm grew into a small industrialized city. In the center of all the activity stood Christian Frederiksen, businessman and owner of Melbo Mansion.

Visitors will get to know Frederiksen and his family through a slideshow of historic photographs, music and adverts for the products that were made in Melbo. Our guide will show you around the mansion and share stories about the family that called this stately house their home.

The mansion has been restored to its former glory, and visitors can enjoy the rich furnishings, as well as interesting historic details. In the servants house next door you can find a museum shop with books and handicrafts. Tours of the english garden are offered by appointment.

Hurtigruten Museum, Stokmarknes

We are building an icon!

THE HURTIGRUTE IS THE HIGHWAY NUMBER 1. Before the advent of road networks and cars, regional flights and aeroplanes, the sea was the most important thoroughfare along the coast. Until 125 years ago there was no regular yearlong connecting traffic between Northern and Southern Norway. Only fishermen and experienced navigators were able to sail and row long distances during the dark season. So when in 1893 the Hurtigrute set sail from Trondheim to Hammerfest, it was a national transport revolution.

The Vesteraalen Dampskipsselskab (VDS) was the first ship company that sailed the Hurtigrute, or Express Route. The ship's name was Vesteraalen, and the company was founded in Stokmarknes - the birthplace of the Hurtigrute. M/S Finnmarken (1956), Norway's largest museum object, will be encased in an iconic museum building. The new museum will open in summer 2020 with exciting new exhibitions and events.

The current museum explores the history of the Hurtigrute from its very beginning and the significance of the postal service, fish, freight and headstrong individuals. It tells of the dark and difficult times during the first and second world wars, as well as of shipwrecks and loss of life. A visit on M/S Finnmarken is included in the ticket price.

M/S Finnmarken will be closed for the public from March 2019 until the new museum opens in summer 2020. During this time the museum will remain open as usual, and this will be the last chance to visit the well-loved exhibition.

8 KILOMETERS FROM SORTLAND you find this charming old trading post. The building is located by the sea, easily accessible by boat – as it had to be in the old days. Time has stood still after the closing of the shop in 1982. Shelves stretched from floor to ceiling display authentic products of all kinds, and the smell of chewing tobacco and ground coffee still lingers in the air.

Jenness Trading Post is located 8 kilometers north west of Sortland (watch for a sign by the road). Visitors can buy locally produced arts and crafts (husflid), postcards, sweets, literature and more. The nearby art gallery (100 m) is also well worth a visit.

BØ MUSEUM IS LOCATED at beautiful surroundings at Vinjesjøen. The theme of the museum is storytelling. The tradition of storytelling is one of the oldest traditions we have that is still alive and well. In Northern Norway the stories were often connected to the landscape and weather. Lots of kids have been frightened by stories of Draugen and the people that live underground, and some are still afraid of the dark. One of our finest storytellers is the author Regine Normann. She tells stories of life in the old times in Bø. She is also an author of fairytales where you get to meet Draugen and some of the other walking dead. These stories are very much connected to our fisherman's cottage and our boathouse.

Artscape Nordland Open Air Gallery and the sculpture The Man from the Sea is located here. So is our Museumshop where you can buy coffee, books and locally handmade products. New summer exhibitions every year.

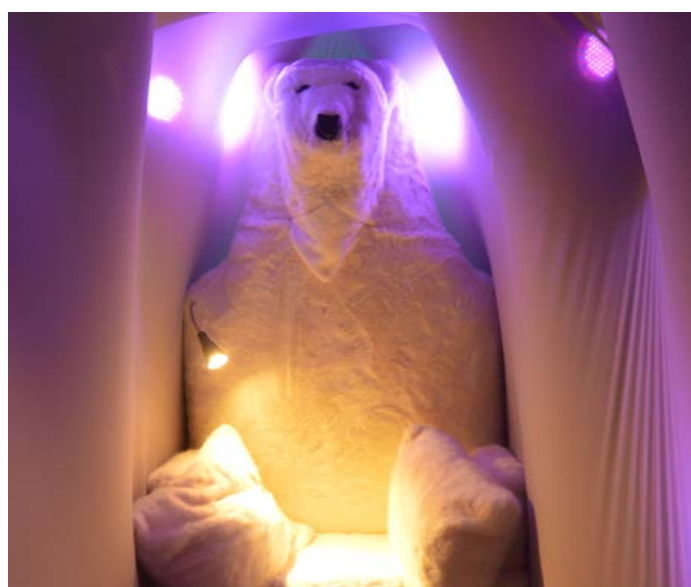

SPREKK – mountains and men in Tysfjord

THE EXHIBITION AT KJØPSVIK MUSEUM is devoted to portraying a significant shift from Norwegian and Sami fishermen-farmer's culture to an industrial society. In 1918 the Nordland Portland Cement Factory (NPC) established operations in Gásluokta/Kjøpsvik and completely transformed the village.

The permanent exhibition tells the story of Tysfjord's development through historical photographs, and local geological materials such as quartz and cement. Norway's national mountain, Stetind, is also featured in the exhibition.

Charming trading post and steamer expedition



KORSNES IS A FORMER HUB in Tysfjord. The village once housed a trading post, a telegraph office and a steam boat expedition. The old village post office here remained amazingly intact. Norwegian author Knut Hamsun worked here for a while, and it's said that he once rescued a merchants daughter from drowning. The charming old buildings are from the 1700–1900s.

Korsnes Museum features an exhibition about photographer Magdalene Norman (1877–1979). In this village she was born and raised, and worked as a mail clerk, shipping agent and photographer. Those who knew her described her as an unusual woman – headstrong and outspoken, with a real appetite for life. Her pictures are the focus of the exhibition.

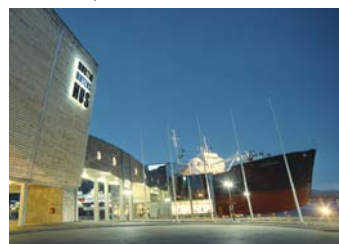

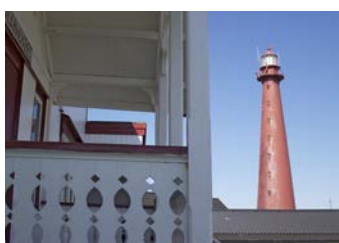
